Grading Process

The Tingara Netball Club grading process involves:

Grading Committee

1. Player assessment during the last round of previous season whilst actively involved in competition
2. Pre-season player assessment (as per dates above). These sessions are compulsory. Please notify us if you are unable to attend.

Coaches: Comment on player performance within their own team from the previous season.

Grading is based on year of birth, not school year, as per FNA requirements.

Every endeavour is made by the Grading Committee to place members appropriately in teams taking into consideration skills and team balance. We cannot guarantee to place your daughter with her friends. Once registration and grading has occurred a portion of fees is **non-refundable** if you choose to withdraw your daughter from Tingara Netball Club.

All teams are then submitted to FNA with Tingara's grade request. The grade of the team is then decided upon by FNA.

Please note FNA will not change teams' grades once the clubs have been notified.

Team announcements will take place at the first training session for each age group.

Umpiring

The Tingara Netball Club is required to provide an umpire for every game that the Club has a team registered in the Fremantle competition.

In 2010, all teams had their fees modified to accommodate the payment of an umpire for each game of the season. Games played at 1.10pm attract a higher umpire fee and highest for the games after 2.35pm. Therefore in 2011, the fee structure will change to reflect the actual umpire costs for each level.

The Umpiring Co-ordinator will attempt to arrange the rostering of paid umpires for each game, but sometimes this may not be possible. In that case, the Umpiring Co-ordinator will insist on the assistance of players. Older players who would like to begin umpiring are encouraged to apply.

Club umpiring payments will be made at the end of each round based on \$15 per game before 1.10pm, \$20 per game at 1.10pm and \$25 per game at or after 2.35pm.

To cover the anticipated 28 umpires needed for club games per week, we **encourage** interest from girls Year 9 and older for inclusion in the Availability Register.

To be included (both Juniors and Seniors), please complete and return the form below with your Registration forms. It is expected that you will commit to all rostered games which will be as convenient to your playing time as we can make them. If you are only available fortnightly, or for part of the season, please still complete the form and the Umpiring Co-ordinator will contact you to discuss your options.

Introduction to Umpiring for DOB 1997s (Year 9's) and older

Year 9's and older who would like to learn to umpire should complete and return the form below with your Registration forms. Please note that this requires a commitment to attending training sessions as well as umpiring at least one game per week as rostered. Full training will be provided before you are expected to umpire on your own.

FNA imposes a fine of \$30 for failure to umpire, along with a team penalty of 2 premiership points. Tingara imposes a further \$30 emergency substitute umpire fee. If you incur a fine you will be unable to play until it is paid.
