We are pleased to note that we have received the first order of the new Club uniforms, and they look terrific! Please keep an eye out for emails in January 2012 advising of early bird opportunities to measure up, pay for and collect the new uniform. The prices are generally less than or equal to those of the old uniform prices.

The registration process for next season will commence as usual early in the New Year. It is anticipated that the Registration Pack will be emailed to all members in mid January. The Registration Pack will also be placed on the Club website. **The Club Registration Day is scheduled for Sunday 12 February 2012 from 10am to 12 noon at Brentwood Primary School.** More details will be available in the Registration Pack.

All coaches and players in teams that may be challenging for finals need to be aware of the particular FNA rules for players to qualify for finals. Please refer to page 33 of the FNA info book - rules 26 and 27.

There are still a number of Tingara teams that have not submitted a photo for the Club website. Please submit the photos as soon as possible to the Club President, Murray King.

Your Committee has decided to split the season end wind-ups into 3 groups this year. Further details will be sent out in due course, but broadly the wind-ups will be as follows:

- Junior Group (grades JH1, JG4, JG2, JF3 and JF1) – Sunday 4 September – sausage sizzle lunch at a local park (venue and exact times to be advised)

1. If a club official/ parent/ supporter wishes to take photographs or video footage of a match (involving players under the age of 18) permission is to be obtained from the opposition team official/s (coach or manager).
2. If permission is not given, please respect and observe the request of the opposition team members and do not proceed with photography or video footage.
3. If there is any dispute or disagreement in relation to photography and videoing on a game, the game should not commence and an Executive official of FNA shall attend and resolve the situation.
4. Concerns regarding inappropriate photography or videoing on the grounds should be reported to the FNA event office and FNA will be responsible to address this matter.

The Tingara Committee is keen to adopt an early start to the process of engaging coaches and managers for the 2012 season. Accordingly, can all players, parents and friends of the Club please earnestly consider volunteering for these essential and much appreciated roles for next season. Your Committee will be directly approaching all current coaches and managers in the next few months in this regard. The earlier we start this process, the more time the Committee will have in filling the roles and assisting in ways to elevate coaching skills.

Similarly, the Tingara Committee is keen to adopt an early start to the process of seeking new members on the Club Committee at the next Club AGM, which will be held in late 2011. If you are interested in taking on a role in the 2012 Committee, please contact one of the current Committee members.
