**PRESIDENT'S REPORT TO MEMBERS FOR**  
**AGM TO BE HELD ON 30 NOVEMBER 2011**

It is with much pleasure that I give the President's Report for the AGM of Tingara Netball Club to be held on 30 November 2011.

**Team Performances**

The 2011 season was highly successful for the Tingara Netball Club. Tingara had 263 registered players in 31 teams ranging from 7 year olds to seniors. We are very proud that 15 of our 26 eligible teams made the finals in 2011, 8 made the grand-finals and we were able to win 4 pennants, with the 17(2), 17(4), 17(6) and JA7 teams being successful. Our 19(1), 17(5), 17(9) and JD7 teams also made it to their respective grand finals and performed most creditably.

**Individual Performances**

A number of Tingara players achieved selection in various representative teams during the season (including FNA teams and Coastal and State academies) and were named as MVPs for various FNA teams. The achievements of these players have been noted in various Club newsletters during the season. Well done girls!

**Wind-ups and Trophies**

Your Management Committee looked at alternative wind-up venues and ideas for 2011 and accordingly held 3 separate wind-ups and trophy presentations this year:

- the wind-up for the JH1, JG4, JG2, JF3 and JF1 teams was held at Tropical Twist.
- the wind-up for the Junior A to E teams was held at La Porchetta Cafe.
- the wind-up for the 17s, 19s and senior teams was held at East Fremantle Yacht Club.

The feedback from all the wind-ups has been most encouraging. Highlights of the wind-ups included the presentation of:

- the 10 year player awards to 8 Tingara players

- the Gladys Buckingham Trophy to Katrina Connell. Katrina leaves the Committee at the end of this year after 4 years of excellent service as the Club Registrar – thank you Katrina!
- the Pat Marsh Encouragement Trophy to Anna Thornton
- the Best Junior Club Member Trophy to Imogen Cook

### **Club Newsletters and Website**

During the year, the Club established a new website, thereby enabling Management Committee to:

- place a lot more photos and information on the website and in a much more timely fashion
- save considerable outgoings in website maintenance fees.

In addition, the Club made much greater use of e-newsletters, which has been well received. This practice will continue in 2012.

### **New Club Uniform**

As a result of feedback from the Club members in a uniform survey held in November 2010, your Management Committee decided that the Club should pursue a change to a new uniform for the 2012 season. The Committee is very pleased with the final product.

The display of the new Club uniform for 2012 was greeted with lots of enthusiasm from the players at the 3 wind-ups. Details of pricing and the process for buying the new uniforms will be available to members in the coming months.

### **Financial Position of Club**

The financial position of the Club continues to remain very healthy. At financial period end (30 September 2011), the Club had approximately \$20,850 in the bank, compared to \$16,750 at 31 December 2010.

### **2012 Season – Coaches and Managers**

The Club is seeking an early start to the engagement of coaches and managers for 2012 season. Please keep an eye out for emails in this regard in the coming months – these are very important roles for the Club.
