It is with great pleasure that I deliver the President's Report for the Annual General Meeting of Tingara Netball Club to be held on 30 November 2021.

2021 has been another fantastic year at Tingara. Following an abbreviated 2020 season, we are very thankful to have enjoyed a close to full winter season this year. The return to more familiar setup for training and game day was a welcome relief.
