Our term one Net program at Brentwood Primary School is now well established and eagerly anticipated by a growing number of budding netballers.

This year Tingara had 44 teams, 9 Set/Go teams, 25 junior teams and 10 senior teams. Our full season comprised 15 qualifying rounds and 3 finals days for the 35 teams eligible to play finals. 13 teams made it through to their respective Grand Final. Tingara had 8 Premiers on Grand Final day.

Our Junior A1 team coached by Corrina Petric, won the prestigious JA1 premiership, making it a clean sweep of junior first division premierships for her team, 5 in a row! It was a busy few hours on court 16 on grand final day with the JB1 and U17/1 teams also premiers.

Our SA1 team also had a fantastic season with a very strong back half of the year seeing them just fall short of qualifying for the finals but consolidating their spot in SA1 for the 2024 winter season. With a very strong junior cohort graduating to seniors over the next couple of years and fantastic numbers throughout the entire club, we're very excited by what the future holds!
