Welcome from the President

It is again with much pleasure that I welcome you to a new netball season at Tingara Netball Club.

The 2012 Committee aims to continue the Club's significant progress made last year, both on and off the netball court. In 2012, the Club will focus on providing the best level of support possible to our players, coaches and managers to assist in their on-field development and success.

In this pack, there is a lot of important information regarding the 2012 netball season. I strongly urge you to review the information contained in this pack and take the appropriate steps to register in a timely fashion for the 2012 season.

As a result of feedback from the Club members in a uniform questionnaire held in November 2010, the Management Committee has introduced a new uniform for the 2012 season. This new uniform is compulsory for all players. The new uniform was modelled at the Club's three wind-ups at the end of the 2011 season and received strong support. The new uniform will be available for purchase in early 2012.

Following a review of the Club's excellent financial position, your Committee has budgeted for a small operating deficit for 2012, thereby using up some of its cash reserves. As a result, despite increased umpire payments budgeted for 2012, registration fee increases for all grades will average 3.3%, which is approximately the same average increase applied by FNA in its fees to the Club.

The on-going success as a Club, both on and off court, would not be possible without the commitment and dedication of your Committee. All key positions on the 2012 Committee were filled at the Club AGM held at the end of November 2011.

The Club's website (www.tingaranetball.com.au), which underwent a significant enhancement last year, contains lots of useful information for Club members, including registration information, photos, news and events, team information, fixtures, contact details, links to other associated websites, club history and the season calendar. We encourage you to use this website as it provides up to date information on all of the Club's activities. A Facebook page linked to the website has now also been established.

Members and their families are again reminded of their obligations to act in accordance with the various Codes of Conduct whilst playing netball for Tingara. Copies of these Codes of Conduct are available in the Fremantle Netball Association information booklet. They are also available on the Tingara website.

On behalf of your Management Committee, I look forward to another successful and enjoyable season for the Tingara Netball Club. **GO TINNIES IN 2012!**

Grading Process

The Tingara Netball Club grading process involves:

Grading Committee

1. Player assessment during the last round of previous season whilst actively involved in competition
2. Pre-season player assessment (as per dates above). These sessions are compulsory.

Coaches: Assessment of player performance within their own team from the previous season.

Grading is based on year of birth, not school year, as per FNA requirements.

Every endeavour is made by the Grading Committee to place members appropriately in teams taking into consideration skills and team balance. We cannot guarantee to place your daughter with her friends. If you choose to withdraw your daughter from Tingara Netball Club once registration and grading has occurred, a portion of fees is **non-refundable**.

All teams are submitted to FNA with Tingara's grade request. The grade of the team is then decided upon by FNA.

Please note FNA will not normally change teams' grades once the clubs have been notified.

Team announcements will take place at the first training session for each age group.

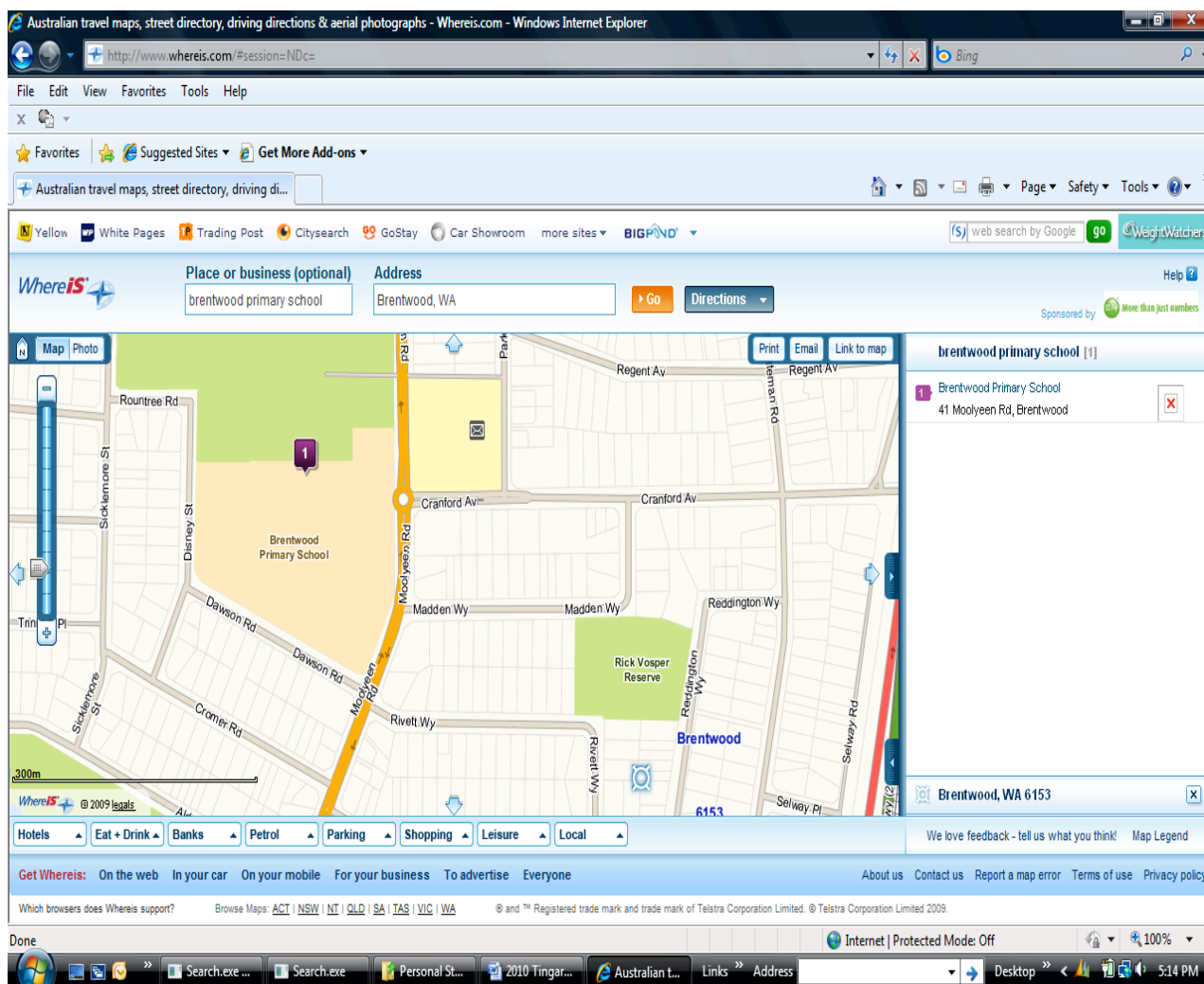

Umpiring

For every game that Tingara plays in the FNA competition, the Club is required to provide an umpire.

The fee structure in 2012 will continue to reflect the actual umpire costs for each level. Very young, higher grade and afternoon games attract varying levels of umpiring fees.

The Umpiring Co-ordinator will attempt to arrange the rostering of paid umpires for each game, but sometimes this may not be possible. In that case, the Umpiring Co-ordinator will insist on the assistance of players. Older players (high school age and above) who would like to begin umpiring are encouraged to apply.

Club umpiring payments will be made at the end of each round based on \$15 per game before 1.10pm, \$20 per game at 1.10pm and \$25 per game at or after 2.35pm. There are additional loadings for experienced, badged, training umpires, as well as loadings for experienced umpires working at 8am.

To cover the anticipated 32 umpires needed for club games per week, we **encourage** interest from players who are high school aged and older for inclusion in the Availability Register.

To be included (both Juniors and Seniors), please complete and return the form below with your Registration forms. It is expected that you will commit to all rostered games which will be as convenient to your playing time as we can make them. If you are only available fortnightly, or for part of the season, or even for 1 or 2 games during the season, please still complete the form and the Umpiring Co-ordinator will contact you to discuss your options.

Introduction to Umpiring

High school age girls and older who would like to learn to umpire should complete and return the form below with your Registration forms. Please note that this requires a commitment to attending training sessions as well as umpiring at least one game per week as rostered. Full training will be provided before you are expected to umpire on your own.

FNA imposes a fine of \$30 for failure to umpire, along with a team penalty of 2 premiership points. Tingara imposes a further \$30 emergency substitute umpire fee. If you incur a fine you will be unable to play until it is paid.
