2020 On-line Registration and Information



Welcome to Tingara Netball Club. Please ensure that you read the entire 'Registration and Information' document before registering so that you understand the expectations and benefits of being a Tingara Netball Club Member for 2020.

Online Registration

The on-line registration for 2020 will be staged as follows:

- **Stage 1: 12 to 18 January 2020**, e-registration will be available to Tingara's members registered in any year since 2014.
 - **Please note**
 - Kidsport applicants need to contact our Registrar directly to assist in the registration process
 - For any siblings wishing to register for the first time, please contact our Registrar to record details and place siblings on the priority placement list
 - Any non-member registrations received during this stage **will be voided**
- **Stage 2: 23 January to 3 February 2020**, e-registration will be open to the general public.
 - **Please note**
 - Registration at this point does not guarantee placement in a Tingara team. The Club may need to close the registration of any particular age group before the nominated closure date to assist in managing high registration numbers. Where a player cannot be placed in a Tingara team, the Club will advise that player/their family as soon as practicable and registration fees will be refunded. If there is an early closure of an age group the Club will make an announcement on its website and/or facebook page.

Important - please note:

1. All on-line registrations must be accompanied by full payment, otherwise registration is void.
2. You are required to indicate during on-line registration where you can make a contribution to the Club. If you are unable to volunteer your time as an umpire, coach, manager, committee member etc, you are strongly encouraged to make a donation to the Club to purchase equipment or to provide sponsorship.
3. Senior players are expected to assist the Club during the year by way of umpiring, team coaching or assisting in specialist coaching activities, Committee membership etc.
4. Tingara is a "grading, training, playing" club. Hence, it seeks to grade the strongest team possible in each grade and players are required to commit to training and playing every week.
5. Late registrations, including returning members who have not registered in time, will be placed on a contact list for team selection, in which case no guarantee of team placement can be made for you/your child.
6. Before completing the Club player on-line registration process, please read the terms and conditions carefully, particularly those regarding your obligations to the Club under its Constitution, By-Laws, playing rules and grading policies

Any absence must be communicated in writing to the Grading Co-ordinator prior to the commencement of grading trials however please note that absences may be taken into account when team placement is considered.

Grading Process

The Club grading process involves the following:

Grading Committee

1. Player assessment during the last round of previous season whilst actively involved in competition
2. Pre-season player assessment (as per dates above).

Coaches: Assessment of player performance and commitment to training and development within their own team from the previous season.

Grading is based on year of birth, not school year, as per FNA and Netball WA requirements. A player who is younger than 18 and new to the Club must produce appropriate proof of age prior to taking the court at grading trials.

Every endeavour is made by the Grading Committee to place members appropriately in teams taking into consideration personal skills, application and team balance. We cannot guarantee to place you/your child with friends, with the exception of the Set H and I age group. If you choose to withdraw yourself/your child from the Club once registration has occurred, a portion, or all, of your fees may be **non-refundable** (at the discretion of the Executive Committee). Requests for withdrawals must be made in writing. However, any withdrawals made after the final date for submission of final Club lists to FNA (normally late May or early June) will result in no refunds of any nature.

Individual players (or their parents) in **the 17s and 19s grades only** may request to 'play up' to a senior grade, this request must be in writing and submitted to the Grading Coordinators at least 2 weeks prior to the commencement of the grading period.

Individual players (or their parents) may request to 'play down' to a lower grade where a legitimate reason exists such as physical capacity or disability. This request must be in writing and submitted to the Grading Coordinator at least 2 weeks prior to the commencement of the registration period. Players will need to provide relevant medical evidence for assessment. It should be noted that the final assessment will be determined by Fremantle Netball Association, not Tingara.

The Tingara Grading Policy has been amended to allow consideration of preformed teams for Senior players in grades Senior A6 and below. A preformed team must consist of 9 players of similar playing level. The team will need to provide their own coach and commit to weekly training and playing for the full season. The team must also participate in the 2 week grading process.

Applications for preformed teams must be made to the Grading Coordinator by 1 February 2020. Confirmation of whether the team has been accepted will be given prior to grading commencing. Once a player is graded and the teams announced, the Club's policy is not to move that player to another team, other than where there are exceptional circumstances (eg where a player is seriously injured and this requires another player to be moved). Players and/or Parents MUST NOT make requests for review of their or their child's grading. To allow such a review would bring unnecessary complexity, uncertainty and instability to the Club grading processes. All teams are submitted to FNA with Tingara's grading request. The grade of the team is then decided upon by FNA.

Team announcements will take place by email.

2020 Training

The proposed training times are as follows. Once team numbers are finalised, confirmation will be communicated. Statement: *In registering with Tingara, You (The player and, if the player is less than 18 years old, the first-named parent), each understands and agrees as follows:*

- To abide by all obligations to the Tingara Netball Club (**Club**) under its Constitution, Playing Rules and Grading Policy.
- Players will be graded into teams in accordance with Club policy.

3. The Club endorses the Fremantle Netball Association (**FNA**) codes of conduct. Therefore you are agreeing to abide by those codes, as well as all other rules, policies and regulations established by the Club, including the Tingara Constitution and By-Laws.
4. You give permission for you or your child's details to be used for all administrative tasks within the Club, including the sharing of contact details with coaches, managers and other Club officials.
5. You acknowledge that the Club and/or FNA may from time to time use you or your child's photograph publicly to promote the Club or FNA. You confirm that by submitting your registration you are giving the Club and/or FNA your permission and authority to use your or your child's photograph publicly to promote the Club or FNA. You understand that the images may be used in print publications, online publications, presentations, websites, and social media. You also understand that no royalty, fee or other compensation shall become payable to me or to my child by FNA or the Club by reason of such use.
6. If you are a new player and younger than 18, then you (or your parent/legal guardian) must produce appropriate proof of your age to a Tingara official when grading commences.
7. You agree to notify the club of any conditions, medical or otherwise, prior to the start of the season. Should any injury occur during a game at FNA, you are required to go to the first aid room to lodge a record of injury for insurance purposes. If you are injured at training, please advise the coach or manager immediately so that an insurance claim can be lodged.
8. You understand that Ambulance travel, if required, will not be covered by FNA Insurance and you will be required to contribute to a gap payment if you do not have your own appropriate ambulance insurance. Please make yourself aware of the limits of your health fund coverage.

Please note these are all subject to change dependent on final team numbers.

Coaching

Tingara encourages parents and players to register as coaches. No previous experience is required and coaches are appointed after discussions with the Coaching Co-ordinator after grading of the players has been finalised. The following support is provided to our coaches:

- Regular pre-season and in-season coaching clinics run by experienced Tingara and external coaches
- Re-imbursement of fees to attend FNA and Netball WA coaching courses and clinics
- Coaching updates, tips and training ideas
- Tingara coaching polo shirt (to be returned at the end of the season)
- Mentoring by experienced Tingara coaches if requested
- Assistant coaching opportunities for those wanting to embark on coaching. Note that juniors are required to be an assistant coach prior to taking on a coaching role.
- Team Manager for each team will assist with administrative duties and equipment

- Re-imbursement of a portion of Tingara's registration fees for players who volunteer to coach
- Secondary School students coaching at Tingara are eligible for community service hours

Umpiring

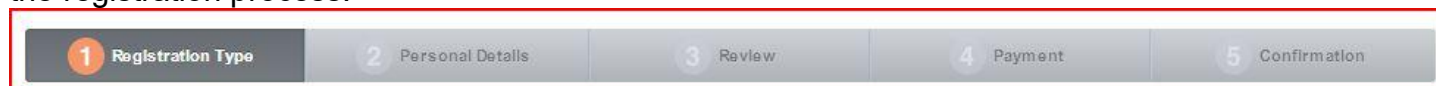
You will be guided to create a new record as part of the registration process.

Register

The registration process requires five steps. These are shown as a menu bar guiding you through the registration process:



Participants will be asked to select NEXT to progress to the next step.

1. Registration Type

The products/registrations available for purchase will be displayed.
Select the desired item and click NEXT.

2. Personal Details

This step allows you to enter/modify your identifying information that is stored in MyNetball. The fields will be blank for new users, but pre-populated for users that have logged in.

3. Review

The Review step allows participants to check the information provided. Click **EDIT DETAILS** to make any amendments. Click **NEXT** when all the information is correct.

4. Payment

The Payment step allows participants to specify how they will pay for the product/registration. Tingara will only accept payment by credit card.
