### Online Registration

Online registration for 2026 will open on **Monday 5<sup>th</sup> January** and close on **Monday 19<sup>th</sup> January**.

There are limited spaces available in each age group so registrations may close earlier than the registration deadline if an age group reaches capacity. In this case, you will be directed to contact the Club Registrar to be placed on a waitlist.

### IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

1. The Tingara Net Skills Program is run during Term 1 of the school year and is separate to the Winter NetSetGo competition. If you would like to register your child for the skills sessions AND the winter competition, you will need to complete two separate registrations using the links above. *Please note: you will only pay the Netball WA and Netball Australia fees once a year per player.*
2. If an age group reaches capacity, please contact Tingara as soon as possible to be placed on a waitlist. Additional places do become available if we are able to meet minimum numbers for an additional team. Places will be offered to those on the waitlist on a first come first served basis.
3. Senior players and Junior/U18 parents are expected to assist the club and will be asked to indicate during registration where you can contribute to the Club as an umpire, coach, manager etc.
4. Tingara is a "grading, training, playing" club. Hence, it seeks to grade the strongest team possible in each grade and players are required to commit to training and playing every week.
5. Attendance at grading is compulsory. If you are unable to attend for any reason, please email our absence mailbox at [gradingabsences@tingaranetball.com.au](mailto:gradingabsences@tingaranetball.com.au)
6. Late registrations, including returning members who have not registered in time, will be placed on a waitlist for team selection.

7. As per FNA requirements, Open teams will need to nominate one player each week to umpire a lower division game at the opposite timeslot to their team's rostered game. Tingara will provide umpire training and recommend that all team members participate where possible.
8.
