



Tingara Club Awards and Process

Tingara Awards

Life Membership: May be given to any person whom the Management Committee deems to have provided outstanding service to the Club over a period of five (5) years (which period does not need to be continuous).

Gladys Buckingham Perpetual Trophy: Awarded to a senior Member (playing or non-playing) to recognise that Member's contribution to the Club over the course of the season or a number of seasons for the benefit of the Club as a whole.

Pat Marsh Encouragement Award: Awarded to a playing Member to recognise that player's courage, determination, consistency, teamwork or other special characteristics (beyond just their playing ability) over the course of the season or a number of seasons.

Junior Club Member Award: Awarded to a Junior A playing Member to recognise that player's contribution for coaching and/or umpiring over the course of the season or a number of seasons for the benefit of the Club as a whole.

Tingara Coaching Award: Awarded to a coach to recognise their dedication, excellence and values in coaching over the course of the season or a number of seasons.

Tingara Umpiring Award: Awarded to an umpire to recognise their dedication, excellence and values in umpiring over the course of the season or a number of seasons.

Award Process

- Sub-committee appointed to administer process, assess nominations and finalise winners. Includes club president and other committee members appointed by committee.
- Call for nominations from Tingara management committee and broader Tingara membership
- Assessment of nominees by sub-committee Awarding of trophies at end of season functions
