A couple of projects the committee has been working on for some time are about to bear fruit.

Firstly, we are pleased to announce that our training base at Brentwood Primary School is about to undergo significant refurbishment. Prior to the 2021 WA State Election, the now Bateman MLA, Kim Giddens on behalf of the McGowan Government made a commitment to Tingara to fund court resurfacing and other works to improve the quality and safety of our facilities. After much collaboration with Brentwood Primary School, we are now in the final stages of preparation for those works to occur. We expect to have a superb environment for our players to train on for the start of the 2022 pre-season.

Equally exciting is the news that after 10 seasons in our current Tingara uniform, we have decided upon a new design to be offered for the 2022 season onwards. In keeping with Netball Australia's recommendation to provide a wider range of uniform design so players are not deterred from playing due to concerns over uniform type, we will be providing the option for any player in any team to wear a dress or a singlet top with either skirt, shorts or skorts. Our passionate uniform sub-committee assure me the uniforms are of the highest quality, look fantastic and are very reasonably priced. More detailed information will follow, but current uniforms will be able to be used for the whole of the 2022 season and we are very keen to help families or players that have difficulty funding new uniforms to transition over the next couple of years.

The clear, crisp September Saturdays we're enjoying at the moment really do bring with them a sense that the winter season is drawing to a close. Our youngest Set and Go players celebrated 2021 at their Jungle Gym windup last Friday and played their last game in glorious sunshine the following day. Radiating joy, their energy and enthusiasm remind us all what netball and community sport is all about; having fun and loving being part of a team of mates.

It has been a great year on court so far. Our players play with great spirit, leaving nothing unspent on court. And our legendary sideline support is second to none. Above all, positivity, fairness and good sportsmanship while giving our absolute all, are Tingara trademarks and I'm sure we'll see that through September! All of us are proud of every team that has represented Tingara this year. We have 7 out of 8 senior teams and 16 out of 25 junior teams that were eligible to qualify for the semi-finals playing this weekend.
