It is again with much pleasure that I welcome you to a new netball season at Tingara Netball Club.

The 2012 Committee aims to continue the Club's significant progress made last year, both on and off the netball court. In 2012, the Club will focus on providing the best level of support possible to our players, coaches and managers to assist in their on-field development and success.

In this pack, there is a lot of important information regarding the 2012 netball season. I strongly urge you to review the information contained in this pack and take the appropriate steps to register in a timely fashion for the 2012 season.

As a result of feedback from the Club members in a uniform questionnaire held in November 2010, the Management Committee has introduced a new uniform for the 2012 season. This new uniform is compulsory for all players. The new uniform was modelled at the Club's three wind-ups at the end of the 2011 season and received strong support. The new uniform will be available for purchase in early 2012.

Following a review of the Club's excellent financial position, your Committee has budgeted for a small operating deficit for 2012, thereby using up some of its cash reserves. As a result, despite increased umpire payments budgeted for 2012, registration fee increases for all grades will average 3.3%, which is approximately the same average increase applied by FNA in its fees to the Club.

The on-going success as a Club, both on and off court, would not be possible without the commitment and dedication of your Committee. All key positions on the 2012 Committee were filled at the Club AGM held at the end of November 2011.

The Club's website (www.tingaranelball.com.au), which underwent a significant enhancement last year, contains lots of useful information for Club members, including registration information, photos, news and events, team information, fixtures, contact details, links to other associated websites, club history and the season calendar. We encourage you to use this website as it provides up to date information on all of the Club's activities. A Facebook page linked to the website has now also been established.

Members and their families are again reminded of their obligations to act in accordance with the various Codes of Conduct whilst playing netball for Tingara. Copies of these Codes of Conduct are available in the Fremantle Netball Association information booklet. They are also available on the Tingara website.
